She believes in a holistic teaching approach that integrates technical vocal training with acting and storytelling, empowering students to express their full artistic potential. At OSU, she mentors both Musical Theatre and Industry majors.

Lyndsee also serves as Director of Communications for NATS-Boston and presented her research at The Voice Foundation Symposium.
